



June 1, 2018 Annual EEO Public File Report for WWST Corporation

- a.) During this period from June 2, 2017 to June 1, 2018, WWST Corporation LLC (i.e. WQKT, WKVX) had two full-time vacancies to be filled. One announcer position and one sales position.
- b.) Therefore, WWST Corporation, LLC (WQKT-WKVX) utilized the following sources to reach candidates for the open position: Sending notices to our EEO recruitment list; posting the opening on both stations' web site, plus the airing of an ad on both WQKT and WKVX.
- c.) From our sources, we gathered resumes and applications from qualified candidates. A total of three applicants for the announcer position were interviewed. One from the advertisement posted on our website and two were on-staff part-time employees. The hire was one of the part-time staffers who was elevated to the full time position. The hire was made on April 30th, 2018.

A total of four candidates for the sales position were interviewed after a review of applications and resumes. One candidate came from in-station referral, two candidates came from the advertised posting on Zip Recruiter and one came from an on-air advertisement on WQKT. The sales position was filled on March 11th, 2018 with a candidate who responded to the on-air station advertisement.
