Civil War Florida

This program focuses on Key West, Fort Zachery Taylor, Battle of Olustee, the Dry Tortugas, Fort Jefferson, and more.



In many respects, Florida remains the forgotten state of the Confederacy. Although the third state to secede, Florida's small population (ranking last among the Confederate states with some 140,000 people), meager industrial resources, and mostly isolated from the other states of the Confederacy made Florida of little strategic importance to either side. Yet it was strategic in controlling the shipping lanes of the Caribbean.

Lynn Herman is the former State Representative in the PA House of Representatives serving the 77th Legislative District largely Philipsburg, Port Matilda, and State College areas of Centre County for 24 years (1983-2006). He is currently a Government Relations/Business Development Consultant and President of Hometown Sports Magazine.
