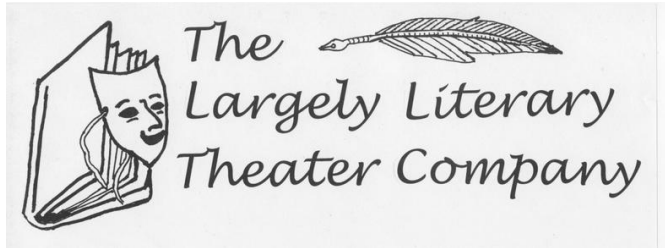


Civil War Round Table

Ghosts of the Civil War: Shades of Blue and Gray



Featuring Largely Literary Theater Company co-founders Sara Showman (from the South) and Mark Dawidziak (from the North), *Ghosts of the Civil War: Shades of Blue and Gray* examines the War Between the States with a mixture of haunting tales, literary selections, song and history. This hour and 20-minute ghostly tour begins in Ohio, with stories drawn from Marietta, a stop on the Underground Railroad, and the still-standing Hope iron furnace, as well as the two Confederate cemeteries that were part of prisoner-of-war camps in Columbus and on Johnson's Island.

The journey continues with stories from South Carolina and Virginia, with a special section about Abraham Lincoln and the White House hauntings. Literary selections include poems by Walt Whitman and Emily Dickinson. Selections from Civil War-era songs are heard throughout the one-act performance.

Dawidziak and Showman founded the touring theater company in 2002 to promote literacy, literature and live theater. They have presented various shows in more than 70 Ohio communities, and their travels also have taken them to such states as New York, Connecticut, Virginia and Michigan. www.largelyliterary.com
